

Spelling Derivatives

For grades 4-8, the words on the District and State test might be derivatives of words that appear on the official Spelling List. A derivative is a word that is related to the word on the list but has a change in the part of speech, a change in the tense, or has an added prefix or suffix. Approximately 8 words on the Grades 4-5 test are derivatives and approximately 14 words on the Grades 6-8 test are derivatives.
